

THE FIRST ANNUAL BED RACE TO HELP HOMELESS CHILDREN & THEIR FAMILIES

How does this work? Individuals or companies can sponsor and/or create beds for the race. A team consists of 5 members: 4 pushers and 1 bed rider. There is a \$100 entry fee per bed. The fundraising goal is for each team member to get 10 people to sponsor them at \$20 each. Five members X \$200 sponsored each = \$1000 funds raised per team. 1ST RECONCILIATION AND 1ST COMMUNION PREP

The Archdiocese of Seattle requires a two-year preparation process for receiving these sacraments. The sacraments are typically received in 2nd grade, though some children may be older. In order to be considered a Year Two candidate the child must have been in our or another parish's faith formation program the previous year or is a student at Assumption Catholic School (ACS). All Year One and Two candidates need to register for and participate in our parish's Whole Community Catechesis program, which begins on **Sept. 10**. Assumption Catholic School families are not required to attend Whole Community Catechesis but are encouraged to join.

PREPARACIÓN PARA LA PRIMERA RECONCILIACIÓN Y PRIMERA COMUNIÓN

La Arquidiócesis de Seattle requiere un proceso de preparación de dos años para recibir estos sacramentos. Set some time aside for Jesus — and for you!

Come join your fellow parishioners on October 28th for a time of prayer and retreat.

Fr. Jordan Bradshaw, OP, will spend the day with us and share some of his insights. We will focus on a few of the concepts from Matthew Kelly's book, *Rediscover Jesus*.

We want to grow in our relationship with the Lord. At Mass recently we heard the Gospel when Jesus asks the disciples, "Who do you say that I am?" We have to ask ourselves that same question over and over again. Who is Jesus for me? And, who does Jesus say that I am?

Fr. Jordan is a priest of the Order of Preachers (the Dominicans) and is responsible for the Newman Center at the University of Washington in Seattle. He is a dynamic, engaging retreat leader and we are thrilled he can come and be with us.
