## **Investing Scriptural Funding Campaign Donations 2013-2014**

Wonder WHY a "capital campaign" is needed at this time? At the First Capital Campaign Rally October 22, Father Scott shared in detail where he, the parish leaders and the Finance Council see the money raised by the Scriptural Funding Campaign being used. Even though the Campaign Honor Goal is \$1,000,000 (with two Stretch Goals – Praise \$1,250,000 and Glory \$1,500,000) it's quite possible – and hoped – that the Honor Goal can be exceeded, given the generosity of our parishioners.

Father reiterated we will NOT spend more than the amount donated. He was clear: we will not go in debt to fund any projects. If the Campaign raises less than a \$1,000,000 some projects will have to be postponed or deleted entirely. On the other hand, if more than a \$1,000,000 is raised, the additional monies will be used to fund additional much needed projects as listed below.

Here's the list of the proposed projects organized into four "Buckets" and a list of "Additional Projects" if we exceed our Honor Goal of \$1,000,000:
