

### Pastor's Note / Nota del Pastor

#### **English**

Welcome to the Church of the Assumption! Whether you are here every Sunday, or this is your first time through our doors, or it is your first time in a while, we are so happy to have you here.

The entire reason we exist is to preach the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ and to carry out his saving mission. And at Easter, the message of the Gospel is *victory over sin and death!* The Lord Jesus has conquered that great enemies of humanity and has given us absolute freedom in Him.

And this victory is personal – whatever struggles, demons, or fears you face, *you personally*, they no longer have any power over you in Christ Jesus. Jesus gives you the strength, he gives you the focus, he gives you the freedom, he gives you the truth, he gives you the peace.

These would only be platitudes if there were no proof. But the proof is the empty tomb! If Jesus can conquer death, he can conquer everything else besides. Have hope! He is risen!
