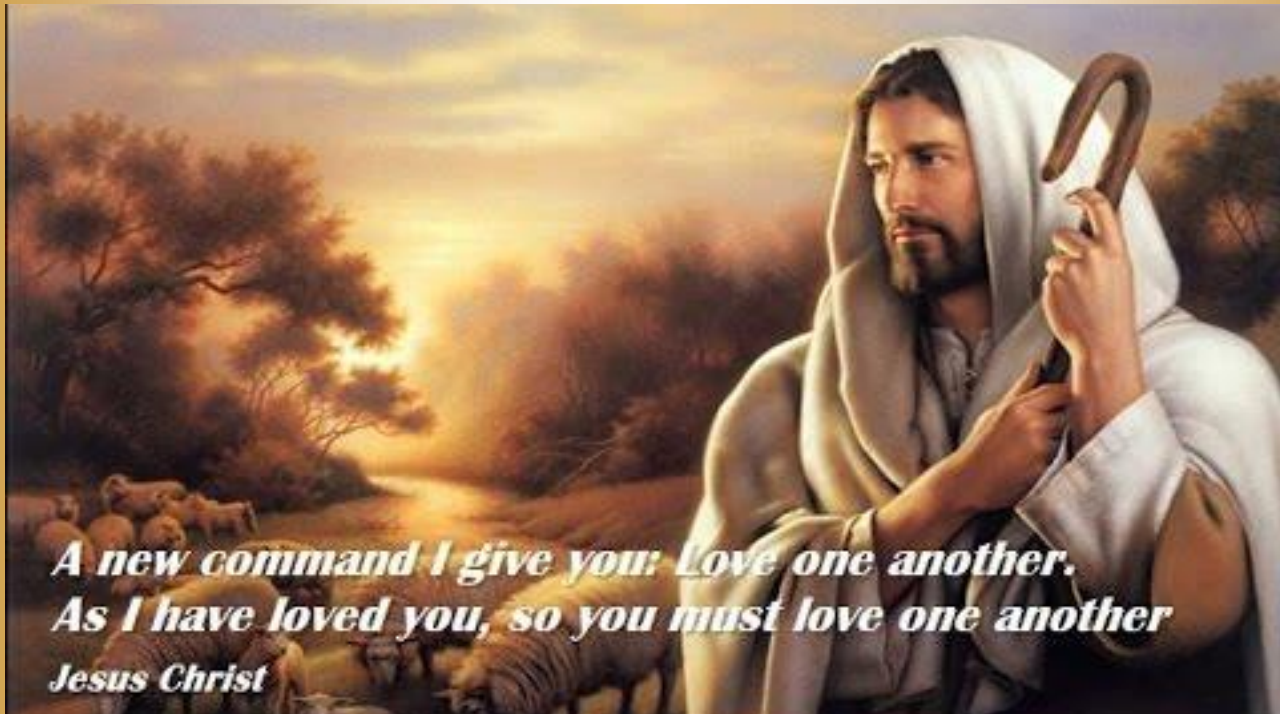

**Save the Date! 1st Annual Camp Out to End Homelessness: June 28, 5pm-June 29, 10am.**

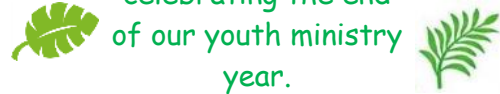

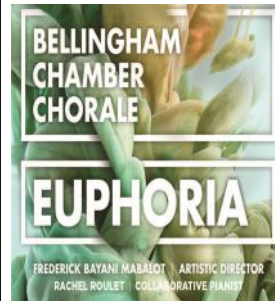

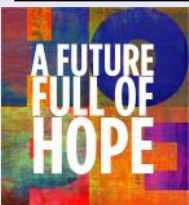
### THANK YOU TO SOY HOUSE RESTAURANT FOR THEIR GENEROSITY
