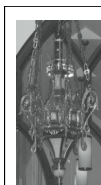

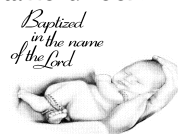

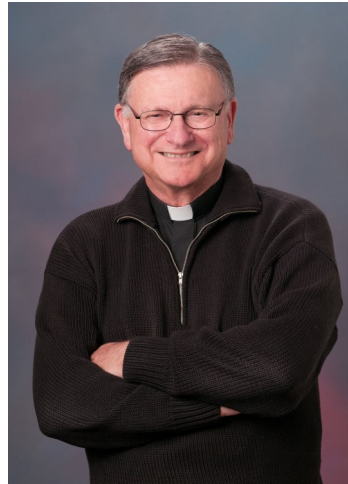

Dear Parishioners:

We’re so excited to get things going on the church floors this coming week! As you know, we intended to fix the floor at the back of the church where the steam pipes had rotted out some of the wood underneath the back pews. We looked into a company who will be helping us and they are able to take on the resurfacing of the entire floor for the same price we had budgeted in our original Capital Campaign estimation. Therefore, next week (July 6th after the Spanish mass) we will be taking out all the pews and putting them into the gym for a week. The floors will be resurfaced and new carpeting will be laid and we plan to be back in the church by July 16th. This means, however, that we will not be able to offer daily mass during the week.
