### Reflection # 12 – He Has Risen Indeed!

Alleluia, Christ has risen! You did it! With parched lips and soul, you made it through 40 days of wandering in the desert, through the agony of the Garden, to the other side of a brutal and lonely journey to Mount of Olives! Finally, you made it to the foot of the Cross—Our Cross—the Cross of Our Salvation where we grieved in solidarity with Our Blessed Mother and our brothers and sisters in Christ. Alleluia, He has risen indeed!

Now it is time for rejoicing! Right? So why, do we still worry? Why do we still fear? It occurred to me earlier this week, as I was praying the Stations of the Cross, (not because I am super holy, mind you, but because I was finally doing my penance three days after the fact) that I am so human, so muddled by the struggles of Adam and Eve, even mid Holy Week! I am not sure why this came as a surprise to me, but as I knelt there and gazed upon Christ on the Cross, I still doubted Our Father's promise that I too can go to heaven. I doubted God's ability to mend broken hearts and bodies, to convert sinners, to overcome anger and I doubted His ability heal relationships. I doubted the totality of God's love, of God's mercy, of God's forgiveness!

And then it occurred to me, if Christ thought we could not be saved, would he have suffered and died on the Cross for me? I was reminded a few weeks back by one of our CORE Team members that Christ actually saw my face as He died on Calvary. He saw my face, riddled by the scars of my sins, those I've already committed and those I will commit, and overcome by His perfect love, mercy, and forgiveness, He still chose to die for me and HE IS RISEN! He has risen indeed!

Now - THIS IS A TIME FOR REJOICING! Wow! This is not a time for subdued, careful rejoicing, but a time for loud bellowing's of "Alleluias!" from the hill tops or the middle of the street or, better yet, safely from your front porches. You have trudged the hard journey to Calvary with Your Savior and He is Triumphant, so blare the trumpets, twirl about in your Sunday's finest, bang your pots and pans, sing, and dance, Our Savior Died for You and He Has Risen, He has Risen Indeed!
