OUR SCHOOL

Assumption Catholic School will be performing "Cinderella" in the school gym with the help of *Missoula Children's Theater*

on **Saturday, May 19, at 3 pm and 6 pm.**

Admission for the show will be \$5 per person or \$20 per family. All Kindergarten through 8th grade students from the parishes are invited to audition on **Monday, May 14, at 3:15 pm** but priority registration (60-member cast) will be given first to students of Assumption School. Rehearsals are every day of the week of May 14, from 3:15 to 8 pm. The cost to participate is \$35 per child. You can find the registration by scanning the QR code attached here.

MASS TIME CHANGES

After a great deal of prayer, discussion, and discernment we wanted to share with you the results regarding the new schedule for Sunday Masses here at the Church of the Assumption. Our objectives were to reduce the number of Sunday Masses from four to three, and provide more time between Masses for catechesis. A survey of parishioners with different Mass time options was fairly inconclusive, with no clear favorite. The staff and our parish leadership group (Pastoral Council, Faith Formation Commission, Spiritual Life and Worship Commission, and Liturgy Planning Committee) met to determine what we believe are the best options for Mass times given our objectives. After looking over all the input, we came up with the following Mass schedule:

Saturday	5:00 pm (English)
Sunday	8:00 am (English)
	9:30 am (English)
Whole Family Catechesis	11:00 am
	12:30 pm (Spanish)

Since the Sunday, 5:00 pm Mass will be eliminated, we want to consider some of the following steps:
—Expand outreach efforts to increase youth in leadership and liturgical roles at all the Masses;
—Provide youth with monthly transportation to the Sunday evening Mass at WWU;
—Include more "Lifeteen" music into all our Sunday liturgies;
—Have a "Youth Mass" once a month either at one particular Mass time or at a variety of times;
—Incorporate a little more Spanish into English Liturgies and a little more English into Spanish liturgies; and
—Conduct a more comprehensive survey of the Sunday, 5:00 pm Mass crowd to see how we can address their concerns.

The new Sunday Mass schedule will take effect on July 1, 2018. We will follow up with more information in the next month or two.

CAMBIOS DE TIEMPO DE MISA

Después de una gran cantidad de oración, discusión y discernimiento, queremos compartir con ustedes los resultados con respecto al nuevo horario para las Misas dominicales aquí en la Iglesia de la Asunción. Nuestros objetivos eran reducir la cantidad de misas dominicales de cuatro a tres y brindar más tiempo entre misas para la catequesis. Una encuesta de feligreses con diferentes opciones de tiempo de la misa no fue concluyente, sin un claro favorito. El personal y nuestro grupo de liderazgo parroquial (Consejo Pastoral, Comisión de Formación de Fe, Comisión de Culto y Vida Espiritual, y Comité de Planificación de Liturgia) se reunieron para determinar cuáles creemos que son las mejores opciones para los tiempos de misas dados nuestros objetivos. Después de revisar todas las aportaciones, se nos ocurrió el siguiente horario:

Sábado	5:00 p.m. (inglés)
Domingo	8:00 a.m. (inglés)
	9:30 a.m. (inglés)
Catequesis para toda la familia a las 11:00 a.m.	
	12:30 p.m. (español)

Ya que la misa de las 5:00 p.m. se eliminará, queremos considerar algunos de los siguientes pasos:

- Ampliar los esfuerzos de alcanzar mas para aumentar la juventud en liderazgo y tomar parte litúrgicos en todas las Misas;
- Proporcionar a los jóvenes transporte mensuales para la misa de los domingos por la tarde en WWU;
- Incluir más música "Lifeteen" en todas nuestras Liturgias dominicales;
- Tener una "Misa para jóvenes" una vez al mes, ya sea en una misa en particular o en una variedad de ocasiones;
- Incorporar un poco más de español a las Liturgias en ingles y un poco más de inglés a las liturgias de español; y
- Realizar una encuesta más compresiva de la gente del domingo de las 5:00 p.m. para ver cómo podemos abordar sus concernientes.

El nuevo horario de la Misa dominical tomara efecto el 1 de julio de 2018. Seguiremos con más información en el próximo mes o dos.

We have our building permits in place and are looking forward to starting construction in the very near future with a hopeful late summer opening!

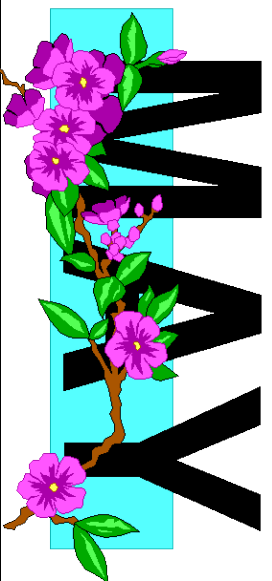
