

Catholic Teaching + Social Justice + Christian Faith = JustFaith Program



Every summer the last 11 years, the bulletins have an invitation to be part of a new JustFaith group forming in the fall. The goal is to learn from the perspective of Catholic Social Teaching about the structural injustices damaging the lives of the poor and marginalized locally and around the world and to provide discernment for future action- ministries of advocacy and direct service.

The commitment of 24 weeks appears daunting for parishioners with life's responsibilities and personal interests. However, consider the rewards-

- Deepen your faith and enrich your spiritual life
- Explore the social mission and teaching of Christianity, focusing on the realities of poverty
- Broaden awareness of the implications of cultural patterns and lifestyle choices
- Inspire creative choices in favor of the Gospel-based vision of peace and justice
- Nurture compassionate responses to the crisis of our times
- Widen circles of connection and care
- Foster solidarity with groups and individuals dealing with the indignities of injustice



The 2014-2015 group, nine of us – two from Sacred Heart, three from Assumption including the Disciple in Service, two from St. Joseph-Ferndale, and two non-Catholics- started in October and met weekly for prayer, and reflection on the books and DVDs. A deeper awareness of the suffering in the world was a common theme to the question- what did you get out of the program. The books used last year give a flavor of the range of topics covered.

- Henri Nouwen's *"Compassion: A Reflection on the Christian Life"*-
- A favorite is Fr. Greg Boyle's work with gangs in L.A. -*"Tattoos on the Heart"*,
- Pope Francis -*"Joy of the Gospel"*,
- A challenging book about economics *"The True Cost of Low Prices: The Violence of Globalization"*
- A sad but life affirming book, *"I Shall Not Hate: A Gaza Doctor's Journey on the Road to Peace and Dignity"* - his three daughters died when a tank shelled their home.

Participants find or create new ministries or new paths for existing ministries, continue their social justice education, and meet regularly building small faith communities for support in preventing mission "burn out" or the "psychic numbing" from hearing about all the sources and situations of injustice in this world and having no idea what to do.



Is this the year you can make a substantial but worthwhile sacrifice of one evening- three hours a week? Please consider and pray about your being at the opening session in October.


PRAY FOR LIFE AT PLANNED PARENTHOOD

Thank you Assumption parishioners for the much needed baby items you gave to the Prepares Traveling Crib. The following items were donated to Hope House through your generosity.

Clothing: 35 onesies, 2 long sleeved shirts, 4 sleep n play sleepers, 6 pairs baby booties, 16 bibs, 3 pairs socks, 6 packages - women's underwear.

Blankets: 4 packs receiving blankets, 6 flannel blankets, 1 crib blanket, 1 crochet blanket.

PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN

The Archdiocese of Seattle has recently changed their Safe Environment program provider to a new company called Virtus. Virtus provides a live training for new volunteers and employees called *Protecting God's Children*. This class is a 3-hour training designed to teach participants how to keep our ministries, programs, and schools safe. Any volunteers who have previously taken the *Called To Protect for Ministries* training DO NOT need to take this new class.

Anyone with an interest in the safety of children and vulnerable adults is encouraged to attend *Protecting God's Children*, however, it is required for new employees and volunteers with ongoing unsupervised contact with minors or vulnerable adults. To be in compliance with the Archdiocese, **all new volunteers must take this training.**

A Stewardship Moment
