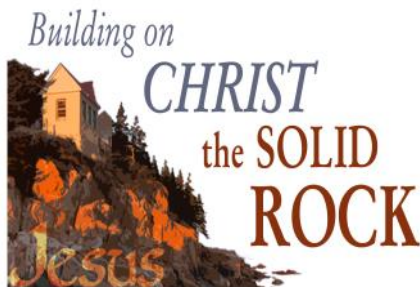

## Sacramental Preparation



### 1ST RECONCILIATION AND 1ST COMMUNION PREP

The Archdiocese of Seattle requires a two-year preparation process for receiving these sacraments. The sacraments are typically received in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, though some children may be older. In order to be considered a Year Two candidate the child must have been in our or another parish's faith formation

program the previous year or is a student at Assumption Catholic School (ACS). All Year One and Two candidates need to register for and participate in our parish's Whole Community Catechesis program, which begins on **Sept. 10**. Assumption Catholic School families are not required to attend Whole Community Catechesis but are encouraged to join.

### PREPARACIÓN PARA LA PRIMERA RECONCILIACIÓN Y PRIMERA COMUNIÓN

La Arquidiócesis de Seattle requiere un proceso de preparación de dos años para recibir estos sacramentos. 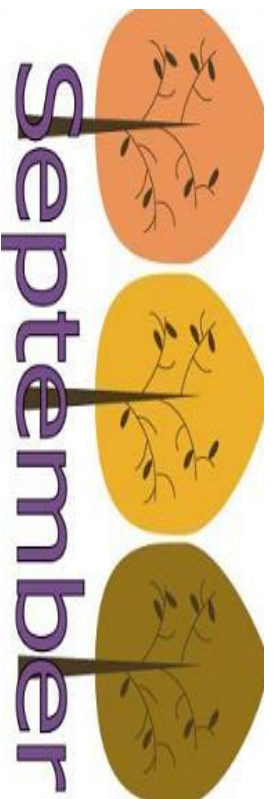
