**GREAT NEWS!**

The Church of the Assumption is pleased to announce that we are the first congregation to host homeless families for the Family Promise program (<https://familypromisewhatcom.org>). Our first week of hosting begins Easter Monday, April 2.

We put out the call for volunteers in 2017 and were amazed to have well over 100 parishioners sign up—our church continues to astound us in its dedication to being the hands of Christ in this world. This is a long-term commitment and we will do our best to make sure each of you get time to work with the program, though it may not be right away.

To be able to participate with Family Promise you must have Safe Environment (Virtus) training, which is easy to do on-line. If you signed up to volunteer, the parish will contact you about what training you need to complete. Also, if you will be interacting with our guests (helping in such areas as meal preparation, visiting, tutoring or overnight supervision) you also must attend a Family Promise volunteer training session, the first of which is being held:

We will hold additional Family Promise training sessions later in the year, but hope you make this first one as it will be lead by the Director of the program and should have a lot of great examples and information. **THE LONGEST WALK 5—WALK WITH US,  
BLAINE TO LUMMI, FEB. 16**

Join the American Indian Movement on the northwest leg of the Longest Walk 5, a national event. The walk's purpose is a rescue mission to heal America from the effects of drugs, violence, suicide, self-harm, and harm to the Earth. The path to healing trauma is finding safety, reckoning with what has happened, and reconnecting with community. Spirituality and community values are critical elements of trauma recovery. Throughout the Walk we hold community events and forums to gather information. As we walk we pick up trash and pray. Throughout the Walk and in community events, the team will explore aspects of spirituality and traditional values that are especially important for Native Americans, but resonate across cultures. We need devoted and passionate walkers.

This leg of the national walk will start at Peace Arch State Park in Blaine with an opening ceremony at 10 AM and the walk beginning at 11 AM. It will end up at the Lummi Tribal offices on the reservation (2665 Kwina Road, Bellingham). You are invited to participate in the entire walk, meet up at some point along the way for a partial walk, or meet the walkers about 12 PM at the Tribal offices.



It's finally beginning! The long process of preparation for a new Hope House has led to the next few months of renewal: we will be closing the present building (Tuesday, the 13<sup>th</sup> is our last day open) and preparing for a brand new space to continue our ministry in. The process is already bitter-sweet for us. While we really need a safer space to work in, there are almost 18 years of memories in this battered old building and many happy memories. We are so grateful for Assumption Parish for the use of this shabby house that has meant a lot to many of your neighbors in need. God bless all the new to come!

Because we are closing until the new building is done, we unfortunately cannot accept any clothing, toys, household items or books, etc. We are going to try to be open in the shed for a temporary ministry of hygiene, baby diapers and formula and emergency food only. If you have any of those to donate, the box will still be in the Gathering Space. PLEASE do not put clothing or housewares in our box until you see a bright shiny new building up! God bless you all for your continued support—stay tuned for the new Hope House!

### SCHOOL DISTINGUISHED GRADUATE AWARD

#### Lou St. Hilaire (Class of '94)

During Catholic Schools Week, we honor a distinguished graduate who exemplifies the attributes of a Catholic education and is a contributing member of the Catholic church. This year the committee selected Mr. Lou St. Hilaire, an active member of the Church of the Assumption and a member of the local council of the Knights of Columbus. Mr. St. Hilaire attended Assumption Catholic School with his five brothers and sisters, graduated in 1994 and then went onto Bellingham High School. From there he graduated from Franciscan University in Steubenville, OH with a Bachelor of Science in Math. He most recently worked for Faith Life here in Bellingham for the creation of Verbum (a digital Catholic study platform) as a tool for the study of Catholic theology. On his own, he produced the first English translation of St. Thomas Aquinas's Literal Exposition of Isaiah. As a member of the Church of the Assumption, he has served in numerous leadership roles as a confirmation and RCIA catechist, a cantor, and as the Grand Knight and Financial Secretary for the Knights of Columbus. He was recently hired at the St. Paul Center for Biblical Theology and will be moving to Steubenville, Ohio, with his wife Jenna and their new daughter, Julie, in May of this year. We are pleased to give him this honor before he moves to the Midwest. Please join me in congratulating Mr. Lou St. Hilaire, this year's recipient of the Assumption Catholic School Distinguished Graduate Award.
