### REFLECTION

#### “Pray, Hope, and Don’t Worry” Saint Padre Pio

The last few weeks at Edge, we’ve been talking about Last Things, (Heaven, Hell, and Purgatory) and Death and Grief. These topics, in combination with the readings from the Book Job this week can make for a heavy heart, but Saint Padre Pio reminds us, “Pray, hope, and don’t worry!”

As most of you know, I try to pull myself from my cozy bed each morning *before* my littles awake and check in with Our Lord. There are days that I awake early ready to roll with the days’ adventures and others where my heart, like the winter weather, feels dark and dreary. There is more worry and less hope on those days, and so, I try to sit still a little longer in prayer — to find my peace and to pray for the willingness to give my worries to Jesus. I also often use my God box. What is a God box you ask? It’s a box, a shoe box, a cereal box, any box or a canister that I can surrender my worries to. I write all my worries down on slips of paper - be they about relationships, my boys, a friend’s health, the recent death of my beloved red-headed aunt, money, my efforts to carve out time for a spiritual life, more sleep and less junk food, anything that is taking up space in my head and distracting me from being fully present to the amazing gift of life before me. THEN...every now and then I look back at the old slips of paper in my God box and EVERYTIME I discover a worry that has been resolved or something that I feel less anxious about. This brings me HOPE!

**So “Pray, Hope and Don’t Worry” and try making your own God box and let me know how it works for you!**

**GREAT NEWS!**

The Church of the Assumption is pleased to announce that we are the first congregation to host homeless families for the Family Promise program (<https://familypromisewhatcom.org>). Our first week hosting begins Easter Monday - April 2nd.

We put out the call for volunteers in 2017 and were amazed to have well over 100 parishioners sign up -- our church continues to astound us in its dedication to being the hands of Christ in this world. This is a long-term commitment and we will do our best to make sure each of you get time to work with the program — it may not be right away.

To be able to participate with Family Promise you must have Safe Environment (Virtus) training, which is easy to do on-line. The parish will contact you if you signed up to volunteer and need to complete this training. Also, if you will be interacting with our guests (helping in such areas as meal preparation, visiting, tutoring or overnight supervision) you also must attend a Family Promise volunteer training session, the first of which is being held:

**TRINITY DOME COLLECTION UPDATE**

The 2017 Trinity Dome Collection has concluded and I'm pleased to report that our archdiocese raised a total of \$85,550.08. This generous gift has been sent to the USCCB Office of National Collections to assist in completing the crowning jewel (dome) of the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington DC. Often referred to as Mary's Shrine, it is the largest Catholic Church in the United States and one of the 10 largest in the world. In preparation for the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the laying of the foundation stone in 1920, the beautiful dome mosaic composed of 14 million pieces of Venetian glass was dedicated last month on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. The great American Shrine exists today as a place of worship, pilgrimage, reconciliation and evangelization due to the generosity of American Catholics and Clergy, the prayers of the faithful, and the hard work of artisans and laborers who began building it nearly 100 years ago. Thank you for your generous support of this one-time national collection.
