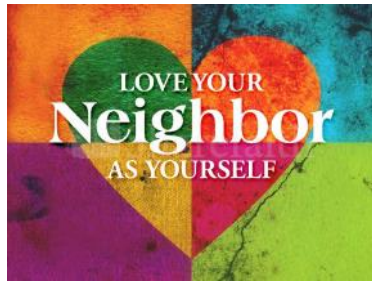

The Corporal Works of Mercy

- Feed the hungry
- Give drink to the thirsty
- Shelter the homeless
- Visit the sick
- Visit the prisoners
- Bury the dead
- Give alms to the poor

The Spiritual Works Of Mercy

- Counsel the doubtful
- Instruct the ignorant
- Admonish the sinner
- Comfort the sorrowful
- Forgive injuries
- Bear wrongs patiently
- Pray for the living and the dead

For example:

- daily prayer, rosary, adoration
- pray at home, at church, at a cemetery
- give food, water or money to the Hope House, Food Bank, Lighthouse Mission, etc.
- visit the lonesome, the sick, the elderly
- visit a nursing home or assisted living
- contact someone you need to forgive
- contact someone from whom you need to ask forgiveness
- contact someone who is struggling with the faith or being unfaithful in their marriage
- contact someone who has lost a loved one and offer to visit/pray with them
- reach out in friendship to someone who is divorced or widowed or is a single parent
- call someone whom you know to be lonesome and visit by phone or in person.

COME AND MEET OLIVIER NDIKUMANA:

July 16 at 6:15 pm in the library

On Saturday July 16 following the 5pm mass, you are invited to a Gathering in the Library Media Center to meet and hear a little bit of the inspiring story of Olivier Ndikumana. Olivier experienced the tragedy of war and genocide in his native Rwanda, and in the aftermath of that experience led different programs that reconciled and reunited young people, regardless of whether their families participated in the genocide or were victims of it. Because of his strong belief that truth must accompany reconciliation, Olivier worked with the United Nations and was hired as a UN volunteer to help disarm and reconcile former rebels in the Cote d'Ivoire (Ivory Coast) so that peace could be sustained in that country.

At this time in his life, Olivier is living in Bellingham, Washington and has been admitted to the Masters' program in Applied International Studies at the Jackson School of the University of Washington. While he has been awarded a partial scholarship for fall 2016 he still has to secure housing and the remaining tuition and fees.

At this time, Olivier is asking for sponsorship to secure the funds and scholarships he needs to enroll in this intensive, one-year program. Please come over to the LMC after mass on Saturday to hear more of his story, and how, out of his own experience and journey toward peace and reconciliation, he has made it his life-work to help heal the deep wounds of our world that encourage hatred and violence. In his own words, "I believe international peace and reconciliation efforts can work and that the church has an important role in such efforts. One of Yours in Christ."
