#### **How has Family Promise been doing since opening?**

Nationally, families stay an average of 9 weeks in Family Promise. Locally, the average is just under a month. There are now more than 20 faith communities in Whatcom County in a support role for our 13 host congregations, and hundreds of volunteers, community-wide, working to help families escape homelessness. What a powerful example of how to work together – thank you for being a vital part of this effort.
