The power of touch is amazing. At Hope House, we often shake hands or even hug our clients. We know that for some of our family members this will be the only touch they feel for days. It is healing, it is an affirmation of their place in this world, and of their value in our eyes. As a Eucharistic minister, I like distributing the Host. I try to always include a small gentle touch when I place the wafer in the recipient's hand. It's a way to affirm our "familyness" as members of the Body of Christ.

Another way we touch at Mass is through our shaking hands at the sign of peace. While this is warm and welcoming as well, for some of our members, it is painful. For those who suffer from arthritis in their hands, the firm handshake of someone with a lot of strength can HURT. I have even noticed some of our members refusing to shake, instead offering a hand to their heart and a warm smile instead. I understand this—I also suffer from arthritis in my hands. I would ask that when shaking someone's hand, please be gentle—you never know when this sign of love and peace can be a source of pain for someone else.

We are in the summer swing now and need lots of food for hungry children, children's shoes and men's clothing—and diapers as usual!
