We have arranged an 8 hour, two part class on Mental Health First Aid for those of our volunteers who are interested and many signed up—they have a real concern for those of our clients who suffer from mental illness and would like more skills to help them. That's the kind of volunteers we have on staff at Hope House!

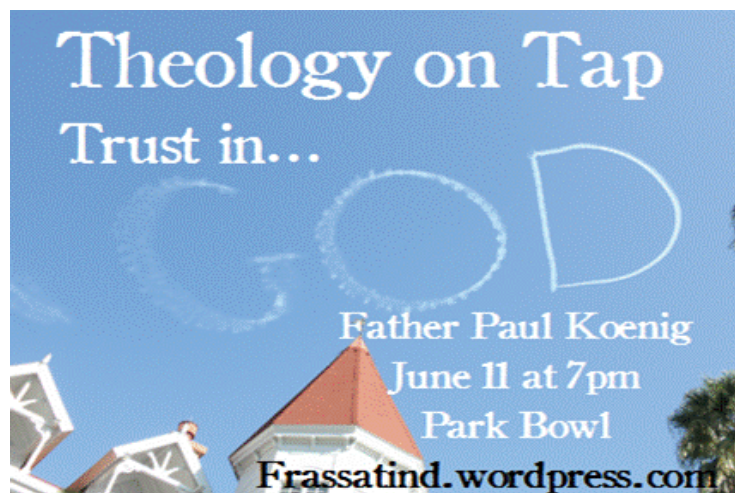
