

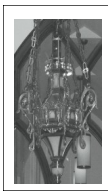

Aviso Urgente

Actualizado el 12 de Marzo de 2014 a las 10:45 A.M.

Recientemente nos hemos dado cuenta que algunos empleados y voluntarios de la Arquidiócesis han sido víctimas de un fraude nacional en su devolución de impuestos.

Los números de seguro social de las víctimas han sido utilizados de forma fraudulenta en declaraciones de impuestos correspondientes al 2013. Tenga la seguridad que estamos tomando las medidas apropiadas para determinar si hubo violación de los sistemas internos de la Arquidiócesis, incluyendo parroquias y escuelas, o de los sistemas de nuestros proveedores, o de alguna otra fuente. Hemos contratado los servicios de la empresa forense de seguridad Stroz Friedberg para que nos asistan en el análisis de la situación. Estamos también en comunicación con el FBI y el IRS para tratar el asunto. Actualizaremos esta página a medida que la información esté disponible.

Todos los empleados y voluntarios de la Arquidiócesis de Seattle deberán tomar las siguientes medidas a la mayor brevedad posible:

1. Llamar a la Unidad Especializada de Protección de Identidad del IRS al 1 (800) 908-4490 ext. 245.
 - a. El representante del IRS le guiará en los pasos a seguir para determinar si su identidad fiscal ha sido comprometida. A tomar en cuenta que si usted presentó declaración mancomunada, ambos cónyuges deberán comunicarse con el representante de la Unidad de Protección de Identidad del IRS.
 - b. Si su identidad no ha sido violada, solicite al IRS que coloque una nota en su expediente. Además, es posible presentar la Forma 14039(SP) “*Declaración Jurada sobre el Robo de Identidad*” para alertar al IRS de lo ocurrido y que pueda afectar su expediente en el futuro. El representante del IRS podrá explicarle este proceso.
 - c. Si su identidad ha sido utilizada, siga las instrucciones del representante del IRS. Los pasos a seguir pueden variar según las circunstancias particulares del contribuyente, pero podrán incluir:
 - i. La preparación y presentación de la Forma 14039(SP) del IRS “*Declaración Jurada sobre el Robo de Identidad*”. Una copia de su identificación deberá acompañar la forma.
 - ii. La comunicación con Equifax al 1 (800) 525-6285 para reportar el fraude. Ellos notificarán a las otras dos principales agencias del reporte de crédito.
 - iii. La presentación del informe de robo a la Comisión Federal de Comercio (FTC). Esto puede hacerse en línea en <https://www.ftccomplaintassistant.gov/#crnt&panel1-1>. Vaya a “How to Create an Identity Report” (Cómo Hacer Reporte de Robo de Identidad) y siga las instrucciones.
 1. La FTC le asignará un número de caso.
 - iv. La presentación de denuncia al departamento de policía. Llame al departamento para obtener instrucciones de cómo hacerlo. En Seattle, este paso puede realizarlo por teléfono.
 1. El departamento de policía le asignará número a su caso.
 - v. La llamada a la Comisión Federal de Comercio (FTC) para reportar el número de caso que le fue asignado por el departamento de policía. Necesitará del número de caso de la FTC para completar este paso.
 - vi. Ponerse en contacto con la Administración del Seguro Social al <http://oig.ssa.gov/espanol/robo-de-identidad>.

Urgent Notice From the Archdiocese

Updated on March 12, 2014 at 10:45 A.M.

It has recently come to our attention that some Archdiocesan employees and volunteers are victims of a national tax refund fraud.

Victims' social security numbers have been used in fraudulent tax returns for the calendar year 2013. Please be assured that we are taking appropriate steps to determine whether or not there has been a breach of systems within the Archdiocese which may include Parishes and Schools, the systems of our vendors, or if there is a problem with some other source. We have hired the forensic security firm Stroz Friedberg to assist us in analyzing and repairing the affected systems. We are also working with the FBI and IRS to address the issue. We will update this site as more information becomes available.

All employees and volunteers of the Archdiocese of Seattle should take the following steps as soon as possible:

1. Call the IRS Identity Protection Specialized Unit at 1(800)908-4490 extension 245.
 - a. The IRS representative will walk you through steps to determine if your tax identity has been compromised. Note: For joint filers, both spouses should speak to an IRS Identity Protection Specialized Unit representative.
 - b. If your identity **has not** been compromised, consider having the IRS place a note on your file in their records. In addition, it is possible to file Form 14039 'Identity Theft Affidavit' to alert the IRS to the risk that an event has occurred that may affect your future income tax filings. The IRS representative can explain this process to you.
 - c. If your identity **has** been compromised, follow the instruction given by the representative. Steps to be taken will vary depending on each individual filer's circumstances, but may include:
 - i. Complete and file IRS Form 14039 'Identity Theft Affidavit'. Note: a copy of your identification will need to be filed with this form.
 - ii. Contact Equifax to report the fraud at 1(800)525-6285. They will notify the other major credit reporting agencies.
 - iii. Submit a report of the theft to the Federal Trade Commission (FTC). This can be done online at www.consumer.ftc.gov/articles/0277-create-identity-theft-report.
 1. Click on "How to Create an Identity Theft Report" and follow the directions listed. The FTC will assign a case number.
 - iv. File a police report with your local police department. Call the department for instructions on how to complete this. In Seattle, this step can be done by phone.
 1. The police department will assign a case number.
 - v. Call the FTC to report the number assigned to the case by the local police department. You will need the FTC case number to complete this step.
 - vi. Contact the Social Security Administration at www.socialsecurity.gov/fraudreport/oig/public_fraud_reporting/form.htm.
2. Further information from the IRS can be found at www.irs.gov/uac/Newsroom/Tips-for-Taxpayers,-Victims-about-Identity-Theft-and-Tax>Returns-2014.
