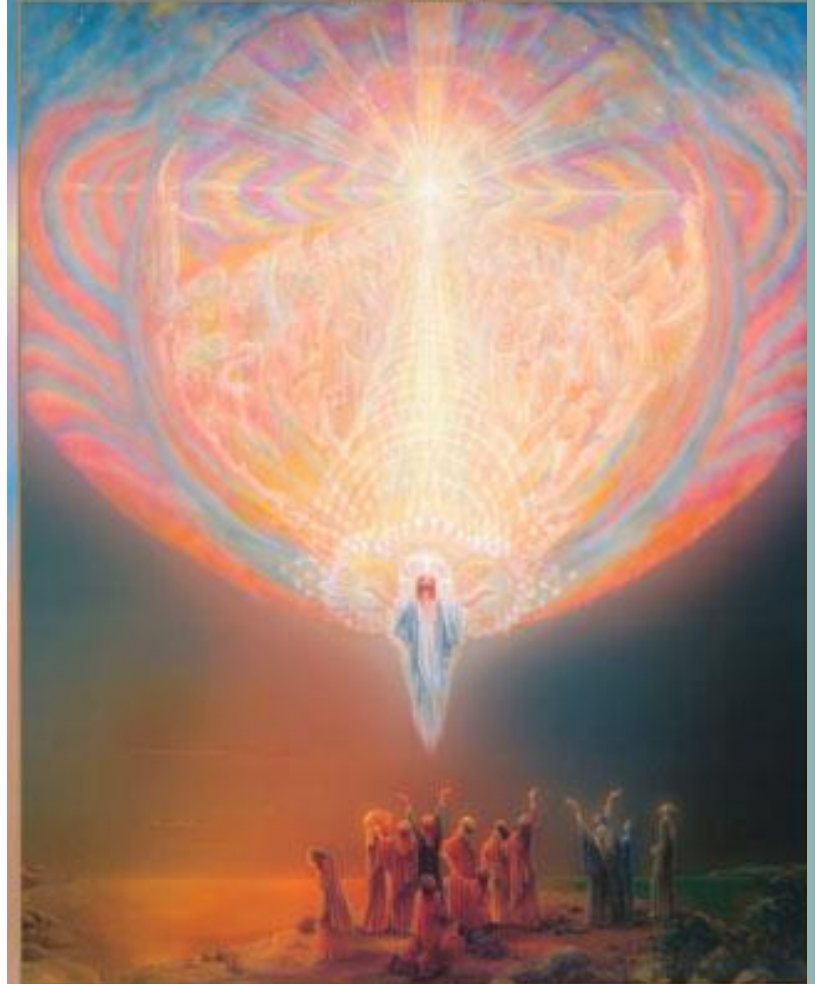

THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

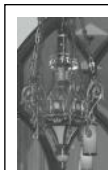

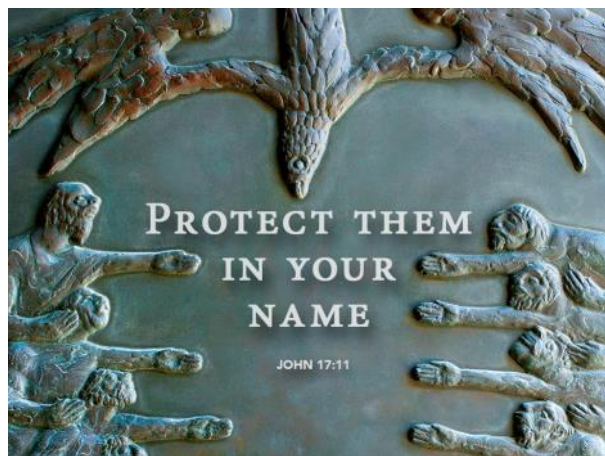

REFLECTION FOR THE YOUTH

Why are you standing there looking at the sky? I am not sure that I am supposed to admit this, but the above sentence makes me chuckle. That’s ok, I think. I mean Jesus had a sense of humor, right? Jesus was like us in every way but sin, so I bet he laughed with his friends like we do and he became angry and frustrated just like us, when he was disrespected, remember; He stormed the temple. When chatting in Edge last week about what the youth learned this year, several youth mentioned learning about Christ’s humanity. I think it’s reasonable to assume that Jesus also did chores for Joseph and Mary. Maybe he did the dishes or took out the garbage too. Perhaps he was supposed to make his bed, do his laundry and he probably had to brush his teeth, and, of course, we know He suffered pain like us too.

So back to the opening sentence, I invite you to visualize this scene, you and your friend are walking down a path, maybe along Whatcom Falls or hiking to Fragrance Lake and you come to a clearing where you see 10 or so people inexplicably staring at the sky. Is it a bird; a plane; or is it Jesus? What?! The event I am referring to is the Ascension of Our Lord. With the Apostles looking on He was lifted up, and a cloud took him from their sight. Acts 1:1-11. Our Lord’s earthly journey had ended, so He departed and arose to heaven with the promise that He would send His Spirit, as I mention in my previous reflection, to be with us on earth.

This year in Edge we studied and discussed the whole of Christ’s life, death and Resurrection. Tying it all together perfectly, the last two weeks of Mass readings focused on God’s love and our call to “Love one another.” John 15:9-15. So in the week ahead, let us take time to “look up” and contemplate Our God, all human and all divine, and remember that in all our humanity, in our moments of joy and sorrow, despair and hope, that HE IS LOVE, that HE loves us and that we are called to extend that very same love to ourselves and to one another.

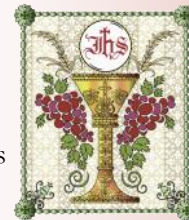
