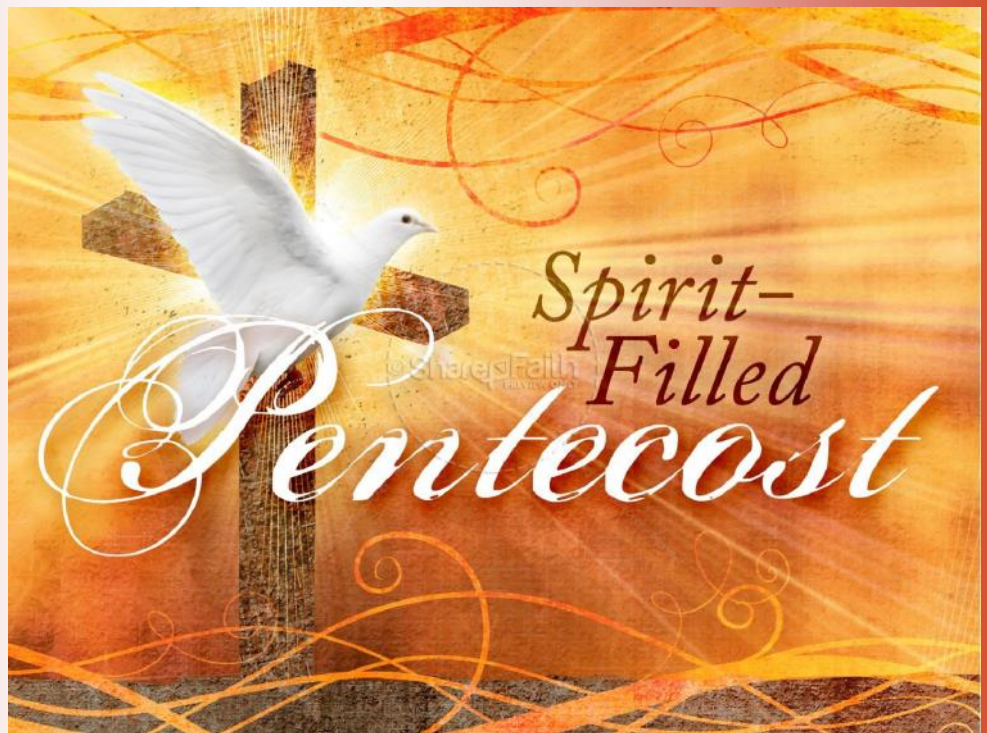

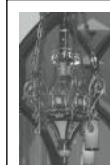

**CONSTRUCTION PROJECT**

Our Capital Campaign, which ended in 2017, was a huge success and raised almost \$1.6 million. One of the projects in the campaign was to clean

the church roof. After the campaign had begun, we discovered that the roof actually needed to be replaced. Leaks had developed in several places and the roof tiles themselves would not bear the weight of someone to clean or repair them.

The Building & Grounds Committee considered multiple options, both for accessing the roof as well as for roofing materials. The best method of access was determined to be scaffolding, which allowed us to use the scaffolding for additional projects such as refurbishing the stained glass windows and cleaning/repairing/painting the exterior of the entire church. After much debate, the committee chose metal roofing for the church. Although it is more expensive, metal tile has been used for centuries as roofing material and has a very long life span.

The workers began erecting the scaffolding in March and the painters started cleaning, sealing and painting the exterior early in April. The mason also began repairing several thousand square feet of brick at that time. The stained glass craftsmen began shortly after that and the roofers began later in April. The project requires that certain trades work on an area first before the next trade can begin on that area. Because of the excellent weather so far, we have made great progress! The project is scheduled to conclude at the end of July.

The total cost for the scaffolding, roofing, stained glass and exterior work is estimated at \$1.45 million. This includes a 23% contingency. The parish has on hand \$650,000 from the Capital Campaign, savings and other restricted gifts. The Archdiocese has agreed to loan our parish up to \$800,000 for the remainder of the project. In an effort to lower the amount we borrow from the Archdiocese, we held a Raise the Roof fundraiser this past weekend.

#### A Stewardship Moment

St. Paul reminds us today that all of our gifts have their source in the Holy Spirit and that those gifts are given "for the common good." What gifts are mine to share?

#### Un Momento De Corresponsabilidad
