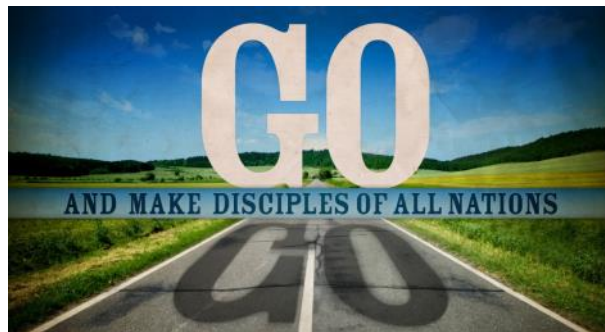

On the Feast of **Corpus Christi** (the Body & Blood of Christ) we will have a collection of wine from our parishioners.



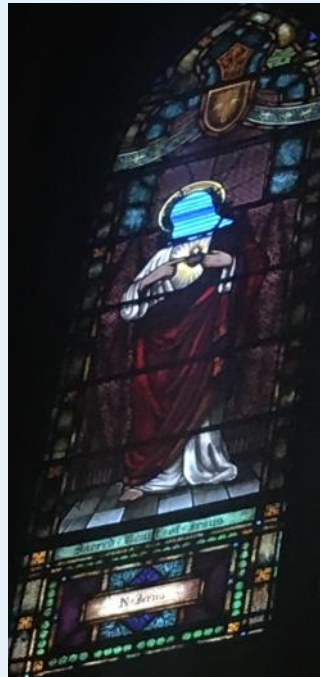
