I recently had a meeting with our musicians about the recent departure of our Pastoral Assistant for Music and Liturgy—Mary Ehle.

We are so sad to see her go, but we need to start looking forward to what we need to do. First, we are trying to set things up for the immediate needs of the music ministry program. To that end, I've asked **Chris Attebery** to step in as the part-time coordinator for our music ministry. She'll be scheduling accompanists and cantors for all masses. She'll also be the contact person for questions people have regarding music ministry. I'll be meeting with her on a regular basis and in turn she will be in touch with all of our musicians.

Bill Turnbull has graciously agreed to serve as Director for the 8:30 mass and will help conduct rehearsals on Thursday evenings. **Jenna St.Hilaire** will be directing the 10:30 mass and **Roman Mata** will stay on as Director for 12:30. **Michelle Richmond** and **Natalie Maeda** have agreed to serve as directors of the LifeTeen Mass on Sunday evenings. Thank you to all of those who have stepped up to help us in these ministries.

Secondly, we will be sitting down with all of our musicians to begin the work of evaluating our music ministry and trying to put next steps in place with regard to hiring a new Pastoral Assistant for Music and Liturgy. I don't have any specific plans right now, but await your input. I doubt that we can get someone in place before Easter as the majority of qualified candidates are likely tied up in their current positions until then. I think we'd be making a bad move to try to hire someone too rapidly. I hate to put things off too long, but I think we need to do it right and make all the proper preparations. In the meantime, let us continue to hold one another in prayer.
