Required Minimum Distributions

If you are planning to make a charitable contribution before the end of the tax year, one option to consider is a distribution from an IRA. Individuals 70 ½ or older can make a contribution directly from an IRA without it being considered a taxable distribution. The donation can meet all or part of the IRA's required minimum distribution for the year. As with all tax law related items, please consult your tax advisor before making any decisions.
