### MOZART'S REQUIEM in our Church next weekend! Concerts by Bellingham Chamber Chorale

Did you know that Mozart was a Catholic? Mozart set the liturgical texts of the Funeral Mass to music for an anonymous patron, but as his health deteriorated, Mozart was convinced that he was composing it for his own funeral. Mozart began composing the piece in early July 1791. He died five months later at the age of 35 on December 5, 1791.

Come hear this choral masterpiece in our church next weekend! **Saturday, March 18<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 p.m. & Sunday, March 19<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p.m.** --- The **Bellingham Chamber Chorale** conducted by our Liturgy and Music Director **Dr. Mabalot** will present two performances of **Mozart's REQUIEM** --- version for soloists, choir, and four hands piano by Carl Czerny.
