#### Partners in the Gospel

Partners in the Gospel is a strategic pastoral planning effort taking place across the Archdiocese of Seattle to re-invigorate and renew our local Catholic Church. Functionally, it is a process to join neighboring parishes together so that, with combined financial, physical, and human resources, our parishes can become stronger than ever. It is currently proposed that the four parishes and four missions of Whatcom County be combined under one pastor, with potentially three assistant priests. The final decision will be announced in February.
