### Main Goal: to help you learn to better Listen

Love

Pray

**Text:** We will be using the School of Healing Prayer Manuals Levels I, II, and III by Christian Healing Ministries. They include an extensive list of Recommended Resources for each level.

**Goals:** This course is a ten month formation to prepare for Healing Prayer Ministry. Prayer ministry helps people who are suffering to experience the love and healing that Jesus offers. The suffering may be physical, emotional, spiritual, or some combination. There is a great need for people who are willing to pray with others, whether in their families, parishes, prayer groups. Develop ability to Listen to the need and Listen to the Lord—to develop “ears to hear.” It is important to Love someone who comes for prayer with the heart of Jesus and learn to Pray as the Holy Spirit leads. Develop the prayer minister’s relationship with God.

What you learn in this course will also help you to be knowledgeable and prepared to pray for people in various situations where spontaneous prayer is appropriate. However the type of in-depth prayer ministry that is taught and anticipated by these classes would always be done as a team of two or three prayer ministers sitting with the person seeking prayers (the supplicant, or recipient).

Ultimately, the purpose of healing prayer is to draw us and the supplicant into deeper intimacy with the Father, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit so that we have the freedom to proclaim the Kingdom of God and walk more fully in His presence.

## **Requirements:**

### **Attend first four sessions to grasp basics of the whole course.**

The first four sessions are germinal to understanding the course. Come to them and decide if this training is for you. Then pay the class fee (\$32 per level) for the manual.

- \*Review and follow your syllabus
- \*Review each lesson within the week after each class
- \*Attend all classes. Put the class dates on your calendar(s).

There are three levels to the course. Each level has about 13 lessons. Included are a teaching DVD along with prayer, fellowship and 'practicing' prayer ministry with classmates.

- \*Arrive by 6:15pm and be ready by 6:30 pm.
- \*Expect to stay until 8:30 pm.
- \*Come back from break promptly.
- \*Participate in prayer, praise and worship and practicum.

Practicum is the small group practice session for prayer ministry that is part of the class. We may be practicing, but the Holy Spirit is not! Healing happens when we pray, whether it's a practice session or not.

- \*Prepare your Family Tree Chart for generational healing sessions.
- \*Participate in the general group discussion time following the lesson presentations.
- \*Make a notebook that holds your prayers for healing and credentials. This is YOUR personal Prayer Notebook.
- \*Maintain confidentiality. Everything shared, prayed about, or discussed in your small group is confidential. Nothing discussed or talked about outside of the small group.
- \*If preparing for Assumption Healing Ministry you need to attend all sessions.

## **Guidelines:**

Students should follow the CHM model as described in the manual and DVDs. Leave previous models of prayer ministry training at the door for now.

- \*Bring your Bible.
- \*During practicum:
  - Listen, Love, Pray
  - Choose who will be the lead prayer minister, who will be the intercessor, and who will be the recipient (supplicant).
  - Pray a prayer of protection
  - Ask the basic questions at each practicum, "May we lay hands on you? May we bless you with Holy Water? May we pray in our prayer language? Are you comfortable with each of us praying for you?"
  - Prayer ministers need to keep EYES OPEN during prayer sessions. The prayer leader and intercessor need to be aware of each other (to communicate) and of the recipient.
  - Finish the session with a Prayer to be Set Free.
  - Debrief with team after prayer.
  - Remember Confidentiality.
