

DID YOU KNOW?

There is an AED (Automated External Defibrillator) available in the church located to the left of the choir behind the altar. Note the sign on the wall marking its location. Sudden cardiac arrest can happen to anyone, anytime, at any age. Time is of the essence. For each minute defibrillation is delayed, the chance of survival is reduced by 10%. An AED is a medical device that analyzes the heart's rhythm. It can be operated by anyone, and no medical background is required. The device is AUTOMATED- it tells you what to do, just open the case. If necessary the AED delivers an electrical shock, known as defibrillation, which helps the heart re-establish an effective rhythm. Familiarize yourself with its location. You could help save a life!

By the third time he came in, we were discussing why and how he fell (it has something to do with shoes on the wrong feet!).

Such an articulate and happy little boy—Jesse is why I go to work each day at Hope House, and if you asked my staff, they would tell you the same. Yes, it's true, we also serve homeless men and women, senior citizens, migrant workers, underemployed adults of all kinds---but it is the children we are there for—the precious souls still full of hope and wonder.

So this week, let's focus on our needs around the children. We need clean, unbroken and complete toys and books; shoes and clothing; diapers and baby items; car seats, walkers, etc. All things children!

INCREASED SECURITY AWARENESS

We need Parishioner support to increase security in and around our Church. The Bellingham you have known has changed dramatically and Police report a significant increase in inner city crime in recent months. We must all take more precautions and be more vigilant. Sadly, we have had a notable increase in vehicle break-ins in our parking lot during our Masses and at other special events. Parishioners can help by insuring that they leave absolutely no valuables in their cars, nothing visible, and always insure auto doors are locked. Leave all valuables at home or locked in your trunk, always take purses or other valuables into the Church, and above all, be alert. Watch what is going on around you and if you see anyone or anything that looks suspicious, please inform the greeters at the door. We will request increased Police patrols, but you, the Parishioner, are the first line of defense. We must insure that our parking lot is not an attractive and easy target for break-ins. If you would like to volunteer to patrol the parking lot during Mass or other special events, please provide your name, email, and phone number to the Church Office. You will be contacted and provided special instructions.
